# FOREVER HERE FOR OUR COMMUNITY


Last year, our Y gave out \$228,367 to support 548 local individuals. In addition, after our closure in March due to COVID-19 and as we reopened, we continued working to help our neighbors in need in a number of ways.

92 — Children served in our essential virtual learning and Child Care programs

4,000+ — Phone calls and socially-distanced visits made to check in on our members

300 — Pounds of food on average collected to benefit local food banks each month

71 — Pints of blood collected during our two blood drives with the American Red Cross **Plus, so much more.** 




## COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS MONTHLY GIVING PROGRAM

This included collecting donations for local hospitals and food banks, offering free virtual exercise classes to keep our community active, hosting community blood drives, continuing our chronic disease prevention programs virtually, and much more.
