

We are excited to offer our Vacation Full Days program for the 2023-2024 School Year. Our program runs on most days that the Scotch Plains-Fanwood public schools are not in session and provides parents with a safe and fun place to send their kids when school is out.

NOW AVAILABLE TO BOTH FSPY MEMBERS AND THE COMMUNITY!

Each Vacation Day has its own theme, with activities built around creativity and learning with a physical fitness component. Open Swim is also included each day, and select days feature trips off-site.

The program is held at our main YMCA building, 1340 Martine Avenue in Scotch Plains from 7:00am-6:30pm. Prior registration is required and can be done online at fspymca.org/register under "Daxko Program Registration" or in-person at our YMCA's Welcome Center.

Please read through the remainder of the brochure to learn more about our program. The registration/health form on pages 3 and 4 must be submitted upon in-person registration, or no later than 7 days before your first scheduled Vacation Day if you register online.

Please note: Unless otherwise noted, please pack a brown bag lunch, bathing suit and towel each day.

Registration Information

- Registration may be done at the Fanwood–Scotch Plains YMCA, 1340 Martine Avenue, Scotch Plains, or online at fspymca.org/register under "Daxko Program Registration."
- Payment and a registration form must be completed for each date attending. Space is limited, so early registration is suggested.
- If you are not currently a Y member, but wish to participate in Vacation Days, you must create a non-member account at fspymca.org/join-the-y and click "Join the Y Today," where a non-member option will be available. You also can visit our Welcome Center at 1340 Martine Avenue.
- Each date must have a minimum requirement of 12 children enrolled. If the Y cancels the program for certain dates due to low enrollment, 7 days notice will be given. Parents will be notified of any cancellation and will be refunded in full.
- If a participant needs to cancel enrollment, YMCA System Credits will only be given when 7 business days notice is received before the scheduled Vacation Full Day. No refunds will be applied if the participant cancels.

Program Information

- Program is open to children in kindergarten through 5th grade.
- All program participants must be signed in and out of the program. Children must be signed in no earlier than 7:00am and signed out by a parent no later than 6:30pm (select dates have an early dismissal).
- The daily program involves both active and quiet indoor and outdoor play (weather and schedule permitting).
- Some Vacation Full Day schedules include a trip to a site away from the YMCA, which requires walking or bus transportation. Children must arrive by 9:00am on trip days. Children must be prepared for the outdoors.
- An afternoon snack is served each Vacation Full Day.
- Trips in the past have included pumpkin picking, roller-skating, bowling, etc.

Location

Participants will be dropped off and picked up at the Fanwood-Scotch Plains YMCA, 1340 Martine Avenue, Scotch Plains.

What to Bring to Each Vacation Day

- Children must bring a morning snack, lunch with a drink (unless otherwise noted), extra water, bathing suit, and towel in a back pack.
- Sneakers and comfortable clothing are a must. Dress appropriately for outdoor weather.
- Please label everything with your child's name.
- Electronics, including Nintendo Switch, iPods, iPads, etc., are not permitted.
- The YMCA is not responsible for lost items.

ultimate team challenge. Children will participate in various team activities including gymnastics and swimming.



Tuesday, December 26: Hello Winter! Warm up with us inside while the weather is cold outside. Join us for a day of hot cocoa and toasty fun.

Wednesday, December 27: Animal Awareness - Join us for a day filled with all things animals. We will learn about animals from all over the world and even have a special guest visit from The Lizard Guys!

Thursday, December 28: Lights, Camera, Action! – This will be a fun-filled day of exciting camera play. Children will make their own commercials, help create an exciting game show, and learn about how TV is made.

Friday, December 29: New Year's Eve Party - Party with us as we enjoy a day full of food, fun, and games! Children will enjoy a new year's lunchtime countdown, complete with an apple cider toast and pizza lunch provided by the Y. Say goodbye to 2023 and hello to 2024.

Monday, January 15: Martin Luther King Jr. Day – join us today as we celebrate the message of Dr. MLK and continue to honor him by spreading unity, peace and equality for all. Children will participate in the Y service projects.

Monday, February 19: Super Hero Adventures – Superman, Spiderman, even the Hulk, you never know who might show up! Wear your favorite superhero costume and show off your super powers in a day full of good deeds and saving the Y from evil.

Monday, March 25: Space Station Exploration – Journey into the deepest regions of space! The Y will be transformed into a space station where children will enjoy a day of hands-on projects focused on space, the planets, and stars.

Tuesday, March 26: Jersey Lanes Bowling - We will depart at 9:30am to go bowling for 2 hours. Wear your craziest socks! We will return by 1:00pm. Don't forget to pack lunch and a bathing suit/towel for swimming.
